



List of documents required in admission for the academic year **2017/2018** for **doctoral (third-cycle), full-time** study programme in the field of , conducted in **Polish, English**, offered at the **Faculty of Physics, Astronomy and Applied Computer Science**, for candidates applying for admission according to **for Polish nationals** and the non-Polish nationals who enrol pursuant to the **rules applicable to Polish nationals**.

Documents required at registration

All candidates in order to confirm their registration are required to submit the following documents:

- application form printed from the individual OAS account and signed by the candidate,
- documents confirming academic achievements, awards, internships, scholarships,
- statement of a research fellow, employed at the Faculty, holding academic title or the academic degree of Doktor Habilitowany, or of a person not employed at the Faculty, authorised by the Faculty Council in which he/she agrees to supervise the prospective doctoral student,
- certificate of grade average obtained within completed second- or long-cycle study programme, calculated in accordance with the regulations of the institution of graduation and issued by this institution, including information about grading scale according to which the grade average was calculated (graduates from first-cycle programmes should also provide the certificate from their first-cycle programme)—required if this information is not included in the diploma supplement,
- curriculum vitae with candidate's academic achievements listed,
- certified translation into English or Polish of all submitted documents issued in a language other than English or Polish.

Documents required upon enrolment

All candidates are required to submit the following documents:

- photograph (35 mm x 45 mm) taken without head covering, against light background,
- photocopy of the ID card or of the passport photograph page (together with the original document available upon request),
- photocopy of the higher education diploma confirming second-cycle qualifications, or of the document confirming the Diamentowy Grant grantee status, or of another document of graduation obtained abroad of Poland, certifying eligibility of the candidate to undertake third-cycle study programmes in the country of issue, or deemed equivalent with a corresponding Polish diploma of graduation from a second-cycle or long-cycle study programme, and if the candidate does not hold the diploma document yet—a certificate issued by the institution of graduation, confirming that they have passed the final diploma examination, including diploma examination grade, diploma dissertation grade, and final diploma grade, as well as confirmation of the eligibility of the candidate to undertake third-cycle study programmes in the country within the education system of which the institution operates (second-cycle study programmes graduates should also provide the certificate for their first-cycle study programme)—together with the original document available for inspection,
- photocopy of higher education diploma supplement or of official transcript of records, and if the candidate does not have it yet, photocopy of student's record book (indeks) or other document including a full list of courses completed and grades received—together with the original document available for inspection,
- doctoral scholarship application (if the candidate applies for a doctoral scholarship), and/or application for doctoral scholarship increase financed with pro-quality tasks earmarked subsidy (if the candidate applies for an increase),
- available upon request: original documents of all scanned copies and photocopies submitted upon registration,
- certified translation into English or Polish of all submitted documents issued in a language other than English or Polish.

Candidates who hold higher education diploma obtained outside Poland are required to submit additionally the following documents:

- higher education diploma obtained outside of Poland is required to be authenticated with apostille or legalised.

Candidates who do not hold Polish citizenship are required to submit additionally the following documents:

- photocopy of document certifying candidate's right to undertake study programmes according to the rules applicable to Polish nationals (together with the original document available upon request),
 - photocopy of the document (with the original document available upon request) which certifies candidate's knowledge of the Polish language—does not apply to candidates who take part in the interview,
 - photocopy of document certifying candidate's possession of health insurance or casualty insurance for the period of studying in Poland, or photocopy of the European Health Insurance Card (together with the original document available upon request), or declaration of taking out the insurance in the National Health Fund (Narodowy Fundusz Zdrowia) immediately upon beginning of the first semester, or enclose signed written declaration that you will submit this document by no later than 29 September 2017—under the pain of withdrawal from the university,
 - photocopy of medical certificate confirming lack of health conditions disqualifying the candidate from undertaking study programme (together with the original document available upon request), or enclose signed written declaration that you will submit this document by no later than 29 September 2017—under the pain of withdrawal from the university.
