## of the Jagiellonian University announces a competition for the post of RESEARCHER ASSISTANT

in the Institute of Physics at the Faculty of Physics, Astronomy and Applied Computer Science in the field of theoretical physics

Eligible candidates must meet the requirements in Article 113, 116 (2) of the "Law on Higher Education and Science" (20 July, 2018) and meet the following qualification criteria:

- hold the degree of magister in physics or an equivalent degree,
- have a doctoral dissertation completed or at an advanced stage, which is confirmed by the opinion of a tutor,
- have a documented scientific achievements,
- possess the knowledge of quantum mechanics and field theory at the university level,
- have basic experience in numerical calculations and/or similar in applications of symbolic, algebraic programs,
- in the case of acceptance, the Jagiellonian University will be their only place of employment.

Successful applicant will be hired from the funds of the NCN Grant "Nonperturbative studies of quantum field theories with gauge symmetry" — UMO-2016/21/B/ST2/01492. The employment is last for one year. There is a possibility to extend the project. He does not perform any teaching duties. The candidate's obligation will consist of carrying the research foreseen in the above project.
