Academic field: theoretical physics

The competitive selection process is open for all individuals, who meet the requirements set out in Articles 113 and 116.2.4) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science, and who meet the following eligibility criteria according to § 166 of the Statute of the Jagiellonian University:

- 1) Holding at least a Master's degree, Master of Science degree;
- 2) Exhibiting aptitude for research work.

- 3. personal questionnaire filled in by the candidate,
- 4. copy of the master's diploma or a doctoral diploma, if applicable,
- 5. information on the candidate's scientific, teaching and organisational achievements,
- 6. list of publications (along with the respective publishing houses and the number of pages), if applicable,
- 7. latest performance evaluation form, if the candidate was subject to such evaluation,
- 8. declaration of the candidate, confirming that the Jagiellonian University will be their primary place of work, should they be selected in the competitive selection process,
- 9. declaration under Article 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science,
- 10. declaration on acknowledging and accepting the rules and regulations concerning intellectual property management and commercialisation in force at the Jagiellonian University,
- 11. information regarding processing of personal data.

The applications should be accompanied by **two recommendation letters** concerning the candidate's scientific work. The recommendation letters should be sent by e-mail directly by their authors to: <a href="www.wydzial.fais@uj.edu.pl">wydzial.fais@uj.edu.pl</a> (in the e-mail title please include name and surname of the recommended candidate).

Application submission deadline: June 17, 2022.

The competitive selection process will be concluded by June 30, 2022.
