

A contest for the position of Scientific Adjunct
in the Astronomical Observatory at the Faculty of Physics, Astronomy and Computer Sciences
in the field of **astronomy**

Eligible contestants must meet the requirements in art. 109, which was established in 27.07.2005 followed by the Law on Higher Education (Dz. U. nr 164, poz. 1365, z późn. zm.) and meet the following qualification criteria:

- Have a PhD degree in physics or astronomy
 - have documented scientific achievements in the field of astronomy and interest in radio astronomy
 - have documented experience in international scientific collaboration and in the presentation of research results at international conferences and symposia
 - active participation in international research projects using radio astronomy instruments, preferably the LOFAR interferometer
 - abilities and willingness for submitting and leading observational projects in the field of galaxies, clusters or pulsar physics using LOFAR instrument
- Have very good written and oral communication skills in English

Candidate should submit the following documents (in English) to the Secretary of the Astronomical Observatory of the Jagiellonian University, ul. Orla 171, 30-244 Cracow, Poland:

- 1) Cover letter,
- 2) CV
- 3) A statement of research interests, scientific experience and achievements
- 4) List of publications
- 5) A copy of a doctoral or habilitation degree
- 6) Two recommendation letters, at least one from outside Poland
- 7) A certificate of proficiency in English
- 8) A statement that Jagiellonian University will be the primary workplace in the case of being hired
